**AIPCC-2023**

Technical committee constituted by AIPSCB vide letter No.1 /Police (Sports)/2023/1172 dated - August 23, 2023 visited Regional Head Quarters, Greyhounds, Vishakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh from 17-19 Oct 2023 in view of 14th All India Police Commando Competition, 2023- 2024. Details of committee members are as under-

Technical Expert Committee has approved following guidelines for conduct of the Competition.

1. Competition will be conducted in accordance with rules prescribed as per **All India Police Commando Competition Rules 2020**, drafted by the Central Committee, All India Police Duty Meet, New Delhi.
2. **Composition of Team** Due to inability of fielding a Gazetted Officer (GO) as Team Captain by certain participating teams, Committee has approved participation of one Offr/ SO and 10 OR, apart from two reserves. Due to administrative challenges, teams are requested not to get more than 20-25 personnel.
3. **Schedule.** Detailed schedule formulated by Committee is attached as **Appendix 'A'**.
4. **Interpreter.** The same will be provided by the conducting agency as per prior request from participating teams
5. **Timeline.** Following timelines have been approved by the Committee:-
  - (a) **Recce.** Due to paucity of time, teams may plan recce of various conduct locations at the earliest. Teams to come recce after **25<sup>th</sup> Dec 23 to 30 Dec-23**. Recce team should not consist of more than **Three** personnel.
  - (b) **Reporting of Teams.** Teams to report Not Before 17<sup>th</sup> Jan 24 and Earliest but not later than 18<sup>th</sup> Jan 24
6. **Navigation (Stage-1)** Considering the security and safety aspect from LWE threat in the area, **Day navigation will be carried out**. Further, it has been taken into consideration after deliberation of various aspects. The following Timing & Score are recommended:-

<b>Time per km</b>	<b>Score</b>
• 20 Min per km	10 Marks
• 20 Min 1 Sec to 22 Min	8 Marks
• 22 Min 1 Sec to 24 Min	6 Marks
• 24 Min 1 Sec to 26 Min	4 Marks
• After 26 Min	2 Marks
• Route not completed	Zero marks

7. **Planning & Plan Presentation (Stage-2)** This event will be conducted after skill test and may extend till late night. Format & mode of conduct is given in rule book.

#### 8. **Skill Test (Stage-3)**

Following Skill tests have been selected by the Technical Committee:-

- **First Aid in Field**
  - **Explosive/ IED/ Assault charge**
  - **Close enemy recce in urban and jungle scenario.**
- a) Participants will be required to write the answer, reply verbally/ show demo/ construct an item where practical. Organizer will ensure Video graphy for the test and keep a record. There will be two Umpires for each skill Test stand. Scoring will be as per difficulty factor of each question score for each skills as per Rule books is 5 Marks for each skill, a total for 15 marks for Three skill (see page-22). This event will be scheduled for 10 to 15 Min per Team.

#### 4. **Events (Stage-4) -**

- Marshalling
  - Briefing for STO-1
  - 1.3 km Run
  - Obstacle Course
  - 2.4 km Run
  - Firing
  - Briefing and Execution for STO-2
- a. Teams will participate as per draw carried out during clinical Conference to be held before the competition.
- b. Briefing and Execution for STO-2 will be carried out separately as per draw.
- c. Time for start of event will depend on whether Condition. Host organization is to start the event in time considering the factor of equal playfield for all.
- d. Weather condition may force the change in time of event leading to spill


- over to subsequent days. All teams must cater for such eventuality.
- e. As per rule book of AIPCC, Total Time allotted for the above events except Briefing and Execution for STO-2 is **1 hour 45 Minutes, however, it will be 86 mins** only. Further, Penalty will be imposed of 2 Marks for every 5 Minutes delay post 86 minutes.
  - f. Total Marks allotted for Briefing and Execution for STO-2 is 35 (10 marks for briefing and 25 marks for Execution). Accordingly, the Assessment Format has been corrected.

**5. Reflex Shooting & Combat Shooting (Stage-5)**

- a. **Reflex Shooting-** The event will be conducted as per Rule book and will be in continuation of stage IV (confidence course).
- b. **Combat Shooting:-** This event will be planned on same parameters as it was conducted in XIII-AIPCC.

**6. Sniper firing (Stage-6)** Due to non-availability of Sniper firing range, the said event shall not be conducted.


**Z. The demo for combat shooting and floor plan for STO-2 will be disseminated** to all participating teams with joining instruction as per 8-b Rule book of AIPCC.

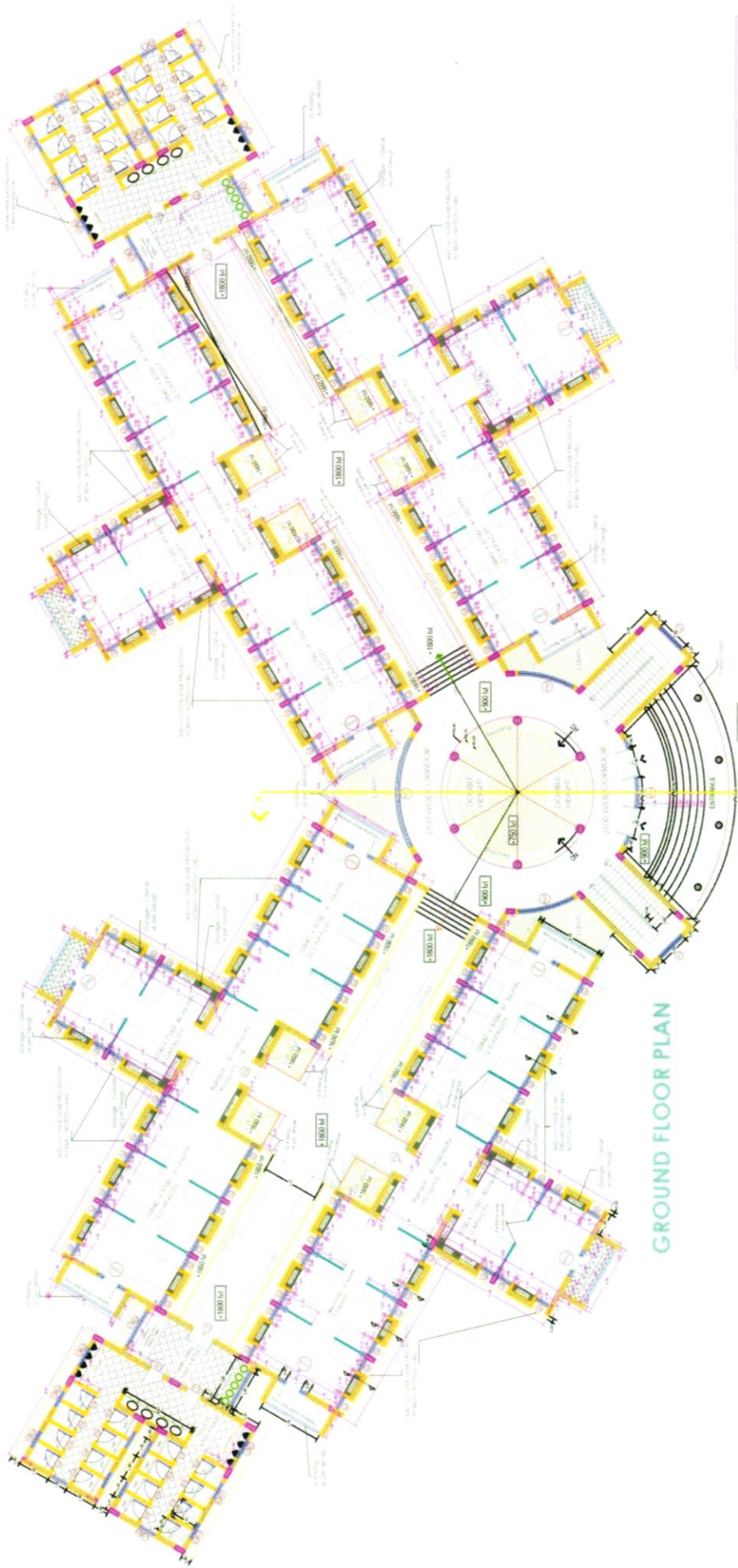
